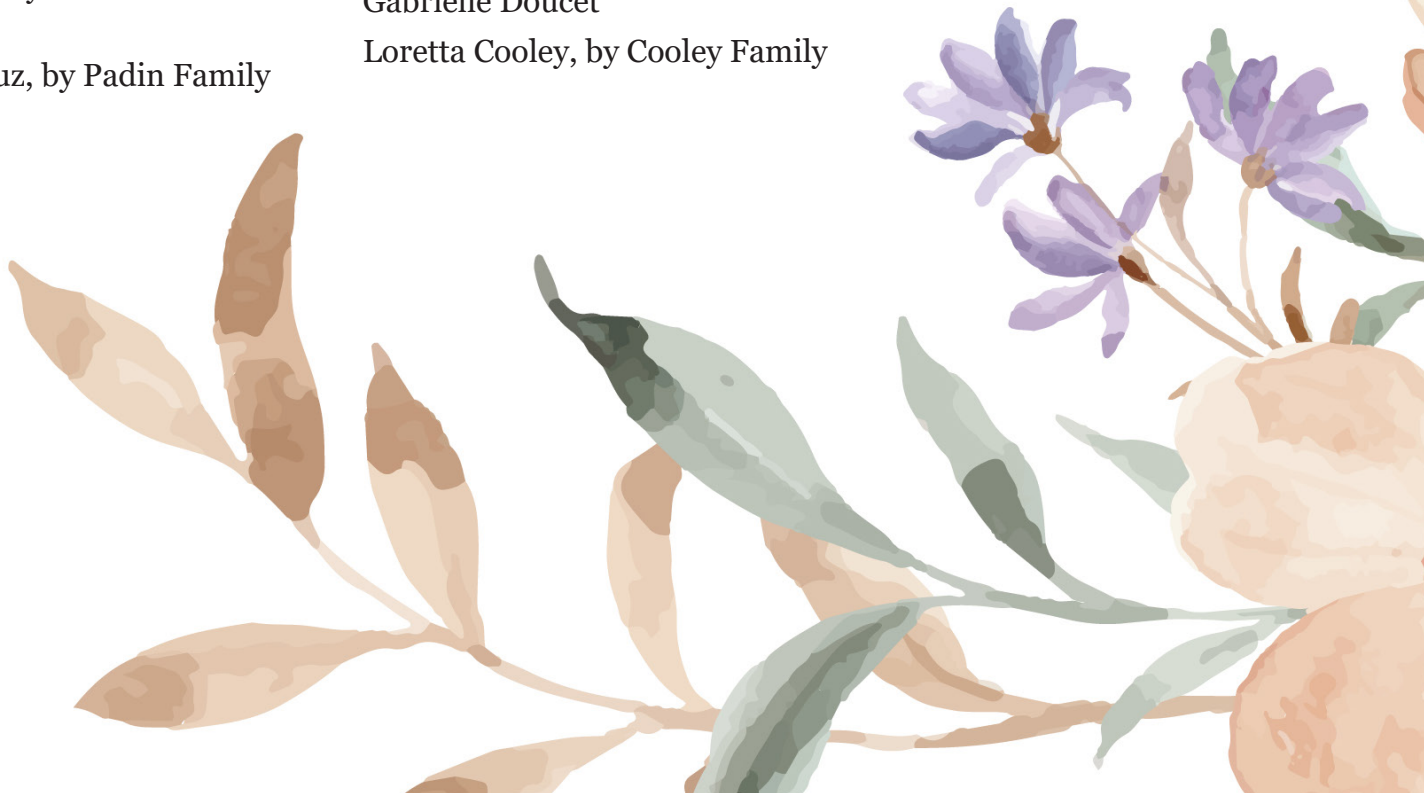

PENTECOST

Pentecost, on Sunday, May 19, always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and 10 days after His ascension into heaven. The timing of these feasts is also where we get the concept of the Novena – nine days of prayer – because in Acts 1, Mary and the Apostles prayed together “continuously” for nine days after the Ascension leading up to Pentecost. Traditionally, the Church prays the Novena to the Holy Spirit in the days before Pentecost. (catholicnewsagency.com)
